Please remember to spin the tubes briefly prior to opening them to avoid any losses that might occur from material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube.
Additional information	<p>This antibody will recognize human SNCA monomers and multimers in Western blot.</p> <p>This antibody binds weakly to fibrils in IHC.</p> <p>Cross reactivity of this antibody to synuclein beta was not determined.</p> <p>This antibody can be used as a capture antibody in ELISA, combined with AS08 358 as a detection antibody.</p>
