Storage	Non-diluted antibody is stable for 4 years at 2-8°C. For storage at -20°C dilute antibody solution with an equal volume of glycerol to obtain final glycerol concentration of 50 % to prevent loss of enzymatic activity. Such solution will not freeze in -20°C. If you are using a 1:5000 dilution prior to diluting with glycerol, then you would need to use a 1:2500 dilution after adding glycerol. Prepare working dilution prior to use and then discard. Be sure to mix well but without foaming.
Additional information	ALP conjugate is supplied in 30 mM Triethanolamine, pH 7,2, 5 mM Magnesium Chloride, 0,1 mM Zinc Chloride, 1 % (w/v) BSA, Protease/IgG free, 0,05 % (w/v) of sodium azide is added as preservative

Confirmed reactivity	Goat IgG heavy and light chains (H&L)

Not reactive in	No confirmed exceptions from predicted reactivity are currently known
Additional information	No reactivity is observed to non-immunoglobulin goat serum proteins based in immunoelectrophoresis. BSA and milk have to be replaced by other blocking reagents, like donkey serum or commercial formulations which are free from bovine IgG.
